OVERVIEW

Kinship is the foundation of a community that unites everything on Earth by honouring our relationship to the land and inspiring innovative solutions to create a new system for our sustainable energy future.

SevenGen first took place in 2019 when Cory Beaver and Disa Crowchief recognized the need to unite Indigenous youth from across Canada. They saw that the energy conversation needed more Indigenous perspectives and that young people needed to understand their own potential and their ability to pursue new opportunities in energy and sustainability.



WHO IS SEVENGEN?

SevenGen is an Indigenous youth-led organization committed to a sustainable and equitable energy future. Our mission is to create a space where Indigenous youth and communities are mobilized to advance in the energy sector through capacity building, program development, mentorship, advocacy. SevenGen envisions a future where our kin seven generations ahead live harmoniously and in honour of protecting the stewardship of the Earth.

SUMMIT OBJECTIVES

LEADERSHIP SKILLS

In a space where leadership is reciprocal, delegates will have the opportunity to learn and lead simultaneously. Learning will be achieved through interactive and informative sessions presented by Indigenous energy leaders. Delegates will be encouraged to voice their concerns and hold government and industry accountable.

Group working sessions will empower delegates with new skills they need to make their voice heard, develop their careers and develop kinship for the future of energy.

PROJECT DEVELOPMENT

During SevenGen, delegates will have the opportunity to collaborate on ideas on energy initiatives and climate action. Project ideas will be organized into groups and matched with experienced mentors in project development and energy systems. Participants will have the opportunity to choose an initiative they support and join the team!

LASTING KINSHIP

In an effort to create lasting and meaningful relationships between Indigenous youth and energy kin, SevenGen will host a series of breakout sessions bringing together tangible ideas, mobilized youth groups, and energy kin to carry these initiatives forward. The sessions will be led by experienced mentors to facilitate and foster an environment to share ideas and create pathways to climate action.
