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
Introduction

This document was created for health care providers in the Northeast BC region. This was developed to give health care providers an understanding of what health services are offered in each First Nations community. The intention of this is to support hospital staff with discharge planning for patients to return back to community with as much support as possible.

Each community is diverse with the services that are being offered. Some communities have several services and others are very limited. It is essential for workers to know what is available in communities so that a proper discharge plan can be created to support the patient in community. It is helpful to know the discharge date so that families can arrange for transportation to return home. Many of the communities are in rural areas quite a distance out of town and it can be difficult to secure transportation for some.




